Addressing Key Challenges in Humanitarian Communication

MASTER OF ADVANCED STUDIES (MAS) IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

3-month core curriculum on the concepts and fundamental issues of humanitarianism.
Two specialisation modules on a specific subject of the student's choice (CAS).
Research methodology
Dissertation to submit in June or August.
Flexibility: MAS can be completed in 1-3 years.

DIPLOMA OF ADVANCED STUDIES (DAS) IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

3-month course taught full-time on humanitarian concepts, contemporary challenges to humanitarian practice including **research methodology**.
Research work to hand over in January.

CERTIFICATES OF ADVANCED STUDIES (CAS) IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

Five 7-week residential or one 8-month distance learning programme on specific subjects.

THEMATIC SHORT COURSES (TSC)

One-week intensive courses on specific themes in humanitarian action.

MASSIVE ONLINE OPEN COURSE (MOOC)

Free 5-week programme on a specific topic.
